Investigation Narrative

On May 6, 2015 at approximately 2106 hours I, D/S Richard Varnadore was dispatched to 7200 Highway 441 North (G4S) in Okeechobee, Florida in reference to information.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Todd Johnson who is the Facility Administrator for G4S. He told me the following (paraphrased)

- I received a fax from Florida Department of Juvenile Justice Central Communications Center in reference to allegations against the staff at G4S.
- The fax has no list of victims or suspects.
- I am going to launch my own internal investigation tomorrow.
- I just needed to report this to Law Enforcement in case something turns up through my investigation.

I then reviewed the fax from the Central Communications Center (CCC) which read as follows.

An anonymous caller contacted the CCC today (5/6/15) and reported the following allegations:

- Staff encourages the youth to fight each other.
- Staff solicits youth to physically assault each other.
- Staff denies youth abuse calls and access to Law Enforcement to press charges when they are assaulted.
- Staff allows youth to access Facebook on desktop computers.
- There is sexual activity occurring between staff and youth that has not been reported.
- A male staff (name unknown) is reportedly a member of the Bloods street gang and flashes gang signs to the youth whom are affiliated with the Crips street gang (rival gang) to agitate them.
- Staff are assaulting youth at the program.

The fax continues to say the allegations need to be reported to law enforcement.

I then explained to Todd without a victim there is no crime. Without a suspect or a victim there is nothing for me to investigate. I told him until there is more information available to me I am unable to conduct a proper investigation.

At this time due to the lack of information this case is considered information only. Todd was provided with a business card with a case number for future references. No further information. END REPORT
