Dear Mr. Quercioli:

As a result of the Predetermination Conference held on July 23, 2015 and after full consideration of your oral response, a decision has been reached. You will be dismissed from your position as a Correctional Officer Sergeant effective August 4, 2015.

This dismissal is the result of your inability to perform your assigned job duties as a Correctional Officer Sergeant based upon documentation provided by your _____ copies of which were previously provided to you with your predetermination conference letter.

This action is being taken in accordance with Chapter 60L-36.005 (3)(c), F.A.C., and Section 110.227, Florida Statutes, copies of which were previously provided to you. As an employee with permanent status and as a member of the Security Services collective bargaining unit, you have the right to either appeal this action pursuant to 447.208, Florida Statutes, or grieve this action, but you cannot use both procedures. If you desire to appeal, written notice must be filed with the Public Employees Relations Commission, 4708 Capital Circle, NW, Suite 300, Tallahassee, FL 32303, within twenty-one (21) calendar days after the date you receive this letter. In the alternative, if you decide to grieve, you must submit your grievance in writing within fifteen (15) business days from the date you receive this letter.
